



Dr. Ted Eisenberg Answers Jennifer Lawrence's Anxiety Over Her Breasts **"Breasts are Sisters, Not Twins"**

Los Angeles, CA (Hollywood Today) 2/6/13/- "My breasts are uneven," says Silver Lining Playbook best actress Oscar nominee Jennifer Lawrence.

Lawrence recently told Jimmy Kimmel Live! host that she went to her doctor to get a chest X-ray of her lungs and discovered that her breasts are uneven. "I was like standing there with these doctors and they're like looking at my lungs and I just couldn't – it felt like an elephant in the room – and I was like, 'Are my breasts uneven,'" says Lawrence. "They were just kind of, like, stifled and uncomfortable, obviously. So I kept thinking, 'Well, I'm gonna dig myself out of this hole by bringing it up again.'"



"Breasts are sisters, not twins," says author of The Scoop on Breasts Dr. Ted Eisenberg. "Few women have identical breasts. Having asymmetrical sized breasts is very common and only about 0.2 percent of the world's population of women can say they are an exact mirror image. Nipple position, chest diameter, the amount of breast tissue, and the location of the breast on the chest will contribute to the appearance of your breasts."
